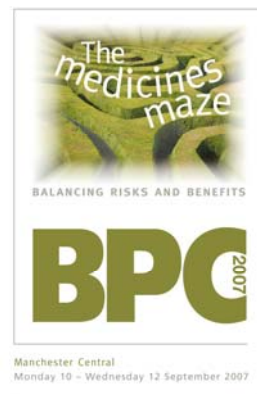

SCIENCE AND PRACTICE ABSTRACTS INVITED FOR BPC 2007

The British Pharmaceutical Conference 2007 (BPC 2007) is now inviting the submission of abstracts in any area of pharmaceutical science or practice research for poster display, and on selection, oral presentation at the 2007 conference.

Abstracts will be reviewed for acceptance by the Royal Pharmaceutical Society of Great Britain (RPSGB) in conjunction with the Academy for Pharmaceutical Sciences for science submissions, and the BPC Practice Research Panel for practice submissions.

Abstracts should relate to original, previously unpublished work, and should be approximately 500 words in length; clear guidelines of the format and submission process can be found on the BPC website. This year for the first time, abstracts can only be submitted online via the BPC website, and applications should be received by 5pm March 16, for practice submissions, and midnight April 15, for science submissions.
